Vehicle Policy for KWC Student Drivers

This policy outlines the requirements for student drivers and procedures to be followed when transporting faculty, staff and students to/from college activities using college owned vehicles.

- Student drivers must be at least 18 years of age.
- Students must have no DUI driving violations in the past three years and no more than two speeding tickets in the past three years.
- Student drivers must provide KWC a copy of their valid drivers license.
- An authorized college employee must be in the vehicle or following behind when a student is driving.
- Drivers are expected to abide by the applicable driving regulations and follow safe driving practices listed below.
 - 1. Require all passengers to remain seated at all times and eliminate distracting activities.
 - 2. Make sure you have unobstructed views of all windows and mirrors.
 - 3. Do not exceed the maximum passenger limit for the vehicle.
 - 4. Monitor all gauges regularly, listen for unusual noises.
 - 5. Be aware of changing driving conditions.
 - 6. Obey posted speed limits.
