Our Mission

Our Goal

Greenwell Library strives to provide quality information services that fulfill the needs of KWC users and are sufficiently flexible to meet the challenges of educational and technological change.

Our Expected Outcomes

- **Outcome #1: Collections**
Develop collections that support the College's curricular programs and independent learning, and are responsive to student and faculty needs.
- **Outcome #2: Access**
Provide access to information resources locally and worldwide.
- **Outcome #3: Information Literacy**
Develop a community of users who can identify, locate, evaluate and effectively use information resources.
- **Outcome #4: Archives**
Maintain an archival collection of materials relevant to the history of the College.
- **Outcome #5: Facilities**
Provide facilities that are conducive to study and work, and are available for use at appropriate hours.

Review of Mission and Goals

Greenwell Library reviews its mission statement periodically in accordance with the review cycle for the mission statement of the College. The staff reviews expected outcomes annually, revising them if necessary. The Library participates in the College's program of institutional assessment, submitting an annual unit assessment report. In the report, the Library identifies and documents the extent to which it is meeting its expected outcomes. Assessment results are used in reviewing outcomes, analyzing services, and drafting plans for the future.
